n June 24, 1717, four Masonic Lodges came together to form the United Grand Lodge of England. This date marks the official change from operative Freemasonry to speculative Freemasonry. June 24th is also St. John the Baptist day. In predominantly Christian nations, Freemasonry has adopted St. John the Baptist and St. John the Evangelist as the patron Saints of Freemasonry. Holy Saints John day is a day of feast occurring twice per year. December 27th, is St. John the Evangelist day.

On June 17th, the Upper East Tennessee York Rite Association will be conferring the Commandery Orders at Kingsport Lodge. If you are a York Rite Mason that is yet to receive the Commandery Orders, this is a great opportunity. Next month we have several events to start preparing for. 






John Walter Sayne 32° Performing at Celebrating the Craft 2017
